

Safety mission statement

Swissfluid AG is responsible for work safety and health protection in accordance with EKAS 6508 (ASA, based on VUV, Art. 11a to 11g).

In accordance with the prevailing, valid regulations, appropriate specialists are called in for advice as required. In addition to the actual quality management, work health and safety are important system processes that must be carefully planned, integrated and audited.

Employees

Swissfluid AG endeavors to provide all employees with a workplace that guarantees the greatest possible safety and physical integrity.

Laws

Swissfluid AG complies with all relevant national laws and regulations.

State

Swissfluid AG works together with the safety authorities of the state (namely SUVA, BIGA, SVTI, BUWAL, SECO etc.) and the authorities of the town of Lenzburg.

Organization

The safety organization (safety officer SIB) is responsible for ensuring that applicable laws, ordinances and regulations are known and monitors compliance with them during operation.

Areas

The safety organization ensures that all safety aspects are observed throughout the company.

Line managers

Line managers have overall responsibility for the safety of their employees, facilities and processes and for following the instructions and guidelines of the safety organization.

Behavior

All employees must contribute responsibly to their own safety and that of their colleagues through their work, their working methods, their behavior and by making suggestions and proposals. This also applies to the protection of systems and processes as well as the environment.

Installations

New systems must be designed and procured in accordance with the current safety level and the relevant standards and regulations (CE conformity, Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC).
